**GIFT ACCEPTANCE POLICY

INTRODUCTION

The Articles of Incorporation and the Code of Regulations provide a general statement of purpose, and the responsibilities, limitations and regulations that govern The Foundation.

The Foundation of the Allegheny Conference, Churches of God, General Conference, solicits and accepts gifts that are consistent with its mission.

Donations will generally be accepted from individuals, partnerships, corporations, foundations, government agencies, or other entities, without limitations.

In the course of its regular fundraising activities, The Foundation of the Allegheny Conference, Churches of God, General Conference, will accept donations of money, real property, personal property, stock or other financial instruments, and in-kind services. Financial instruments and other gifts may be liquidated at the discretion of the Foundation Board of Directors.

All gifts will be reviewed prior to acceptance for any special liabilities they may pose for The Foundation of the Allegheny Conference, Churches of God, General Conference.

Gifts of stock or financial instruments may be liquidated at the discretion of the Foundation Board.

ADOPTION OF GIFT ACCEPTANCE POLICY

The Board of Directors adopts this Gift Acceptance Policy as a general policy relating to receiving gifts or donations by The Foundation.
